Almost 150 primary and secondary school children from schools across Perth & Kinross, Dundee and Angus are attending! Sportshall Athletics is a fun and challenging event using indoor athletics equipment and 10 young people from the event will be selected to attend the national event in March at Grangemouth Sports Complex. All pupils participating will have physical, learning or sensory impairments or other additional support needs.

- To assist the organiser deliver a regional event to primary and secondary pupils in a safe and supported environment
- Help set up the event prior to event start time of 10.15am
- To help meet and greet schools and pupils when they arrive and support the Branch Administrator with registration
- To support one of 8 groups of children take part in a variety of indoor athletics activities and remain with the same group throughout
- To understand the main adaptations to all events (numerous options will be explained) with flexibility for you to be creative when required to ensure everyone is included in a meaningful way
- Contribute to the positive ethos of the event with an enthusiastic and motivating approach
- To assist the organiser in ensuring all Health and Safety policies and procedures are correctly adhered to (these will be shared with you in advance)
- At the debrief, contribute to making nominations for 10 athletes to be selected to attend the national event based on skill, effort and determination of the pupil

Skills/Aptitudes/Qualifications Required

- A smile, a willingness to help children with disabilities to maximise their potential and to have fun are the key requirements!
